## Responders Invitational Bidding

How do I know what kind of hand I have after partner opens?
Minimum: $5-9$ points
Invitational: $10-12$ points
Game Force: 13+
How can I show my partner what kind of hand I have?
With minimum hand (responder bids in bold):

- Raise partner's suit: $\mathbf{1 \vee} \mathbf{- 2 V}$
- Rebid own suit: $1 \boldsymbol{-} \mathbf{1 s}-1 \mathrm{NT}-\mathbf{2 s}$

- Rebid suit lower ranking than opening bid: $1 \uparrow-\mathbf{1 s}-1$ NT $-\mathbf{2}$


## With an invitational hand (responder bids in bold):

- Jump raise partner's suit with four-card support: 19-1母-14-34
- Raise to 3 in agreed suit: $\mathbf{1 0}-\mathbf{1 V}-2 \boldsymbol{-} \mathbf{3 V}$
- Raise partner's notrump bid: $1 \boldsymbol{1}-\mathbf{1 s}-1 \mathrm{NT}-\mathbf{2 N T}$
- Jump to 2NT to invite 3NT. Note do NOT do this if you have a four card major you can bid at the 1-level: 1

How can I show that I have two suits (5-5) and an invitational hand?

- Open with your highest ranking suit, then jump bid the lower ranking suit: $1 \boldsymbol{2}-\mathbf{1 4}$ -1NT-3ワ (responder bids in bold)

How should the opener respond to an invitational bid by responder? Opener has already shown a minimal hand (12-15). Responder is inviting game if the opener is at the upper end of this range (14-15):

- With 14-15 HCP for NT or 14-15 support points (HCP plus distribution) for suit contracts, opener should bid on to game.
- On 12-13 HCP/support point minimums, opener should stay in part score.
- When the responder shows two suits and opener has a minimum, opener can rebid the first suit to show suit preference but no interest in game: 12-19-1NT-3-3s (responder bids in bold)
- When opener returns to their major after a 2NT invitational bid by responder, rebidding the major shows a minimum with 6 cards in the suit. If responder has 2 -card support they can add support points (if any) and possibly go to game with additional values.
